Mid-Year Narrative:

The data from the Spring 2022 PSAT/SAT suite to the Fall 2022 PSAT/NMSQT suite provided promising growth results. Current Freshman mean overall growth was +70.4 points. Current Sophomore mean overall growth was +41.7 points. Finally, the current Junior mean overall growth was +60.7 points. All classes are on track to meet the End of Year Academic Goal of overall growth of at least +30 points for the PSAT/SAT suite.

End of Year Narrative:

At this time, results have yet to come through from the Spring 2023 PSAT/SAT suite of assessments. The positive trend is that the End of Year goals were achieved by the Middle of the Year, every level with at least a +30 mean overall growth.

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
