Programming: The Charyl Stockwell Academy District applied for the Section 98c Learning Loss grant and will use the funds for the following resources. This list of resources takes into consideration needs across the District. These resources would be utilized to supplement and support instruction in reading and mathematics. They would be utilized to provide interventions to students.

CSA Elementary:

- IXL Math and Reading (\$10,000.00 for 500 students and professional development)
- Reflex Math site license (\$3,295.00)
- Salary for additional support staff to provide classroom intervention \$36,450

CSAMS:

- IXL Math and Reading (\$6,205.00 for student site licenses)
- Reflex Math site license (\$3,295.00)

Implementation Timeline: We would begin to utilize the site licenses for IXL and Reflex Math at the beginning of the school year. Students would utilize these two websites throughout the year both at school and would also have access at home to supplement instruction. Additional support staff would be utilized to provide interventions in the classroom with students identified as needing additional support in reading and/or mathematics.

Metrics Used to Evaluate: We would utilize NWEA MAP growth test scores for reading and mathematics at both the elementary and middle school levels. PSAT and SAT data would be utilized to analyze effectiveness at CSPA.

Estimated Costs: Total Costs for all Items across the district is \$59,245.00
